

National Level Webinar on

"How to Improve Your Academic Reputation by Avoiding Plagiarism"







The Knowledge Resource Centre (Library) of the college, in association with the Research Development Centre, organized a National Level Webinar on "How to Improve Your Academic Reputation by Avoiding Plagiarism" on the 5th June, 2020.

Prin. Dr. R.K. Patra, introduced the theme of the webinar. Librarian Mr. Uday Kulkarni introduce the Resource person of the webinar.

Dr. Manju Naika, Chief Library Officer, IIT Mumbai enlightened the participating faculty members and research scholars on various aspects contributing to the enrichment of one's research.

He educated the delegates as to how to calculate the impact factor of a research journal. Introducing various types of plagiarism, he cautioned against the consequences of the same. He introduced plagiarism detections and plagiarism.net available online. The delegates were also enlightened regarding the importance if citation with a detailed guidance in citation styles MLA quotations, citation management tools etc.

He then guided regarding the ways in which plagiarism can be avoided by structuring the manuscript using IMRad format.

The delegates were also advised on how to select a journal for publishing one's research work using resources like journal suggester and how to avoid predatory publications.

Dr. Naika further explained the common reasons for manuscript rejection. Different language editing services available online were also informed.

The delegates were educated regarding the online digital repository, ORCID, Altmetrics, hindex as well as acceptable file formats for research.
